

BRITZ AUSTRALIA CHILD & BOOSTER SEAT POLICY

01 April 2013 - 31 March 2014



THE TYPE OF RESTRAINT REQUIRED FOR YOUR CHILD DEPENDS ON THEIR AGE

- Children aged **under six months** must wear an approved, properly fastened and adjusted, rear facing child restraint. Children in this category cannot be seated in the front of our vehicles.
- Children aged **between six months and under four years** must wear an approved, properly fastened and adjusted, rear facing child restraint OR a forward facing child restraint with an in-built harness. Children in this category cannot be seated in the front of our vehicles.
- Children aged **between four years and under seven** must wear an approved, properly fastened and adjusted, forward facing child restraint with an in-built harness OR an approved booster seat which is properly positioned and fastened. Whilst it is legal for a child in this category to sit in the front seat, Britz does not recommend any child under 26kgs or under seven years travels in the front seat.

WHERE YOUR CHILD CAN SIT:

- Front seats in all vehicles are not fitted with anchor points and cannot accommodate children **under four** years in any case.
- If all appropriate rear seats are being used by children **under seven** years, children aged between **four and six years** (inclusive) may travel in the front seat, provided they use an approved restraint or booster seat.

HiTop 2BB

This vehicle has positioning for a total of one child restraint.

Baby seats cannot be fitted in this vehicle. Children **under four years** must not travel in this vehicle.

One booster seat (**minimum four years of age**) needs to be strapped in the front passenger seat with the diagonal lap-sash seatbelt by law. Any other travellers will need to sit in the middle seat. As this may be a tight fit it is recommended that when travelling with a child, a Britz Voyager or Britz Explorer is considered.



Voyager 4BBXS

This vehicle has positioning for a total of two child restraints.

Two baby seats (**three years and under**) can be fitted to the rear forward facing seat with a baby bolt.

OR two booster seats (**minimum four years of age**) can be fitted to the rear seats of this vehicle using a lap belt with additional harness.



Venturer 2BTSBV

This vehicle has positioning for a total of one child restraint.

Baby seats cannot be fitted in this vehicle.

Children **under four years** must not travel in this vehicle.

One booster seat (**minimum four years of age**) needs to be strapped in the front passenger seat with the diagonal lap-sash seatbelt by law.

Explorer 4BB

This vehicle has positioning for a total of two child restraints.

Two baby seats (**three years and under**) can be fitted to the rear forward facing seats with a baby bolt.

OR two booster seats (**minimum four years of age**) can be fitted to the rear dinette seats of this vehicle with a diagonal lap-sash belt.



Renegade 6BBR

This vehicle has positioning for a total of four child restraints.

Two baby seats (**three years and under**) can be fitted to the rear forward facing seat in the vehicle cab with a baby bolt.

OR four booster seats (**minimum four years of age**) can be fitted to the rear seat in the vehicle cab with a diagonal lap-sash belt. This may be a tight fit as booster seats will sit side by side.



Frontier 6BB

This vehicle has positioning for a total of four child restraints.

Two baby seats (**three years and under**) can be fitted to the rear forward facing dinette seat with a baby bolt.

OR four booster seats (**minimum four years of age**) can be fitted to the rear dinette seats with a diagonal lap-sash belt.



Bushcamper 2B4WDB

This vehicle has positioning for a total of one child restraint.

Baby seats cannot be fitted in this vehicle. Children **under four years** must not travel in this vehicle.

One booster seat (**minimum four years of age**) needs to be strapped in the front passenger seat with the diagonal lap-sash seatbelt by law. Any other travellers will need to sit in the middle seat. As this may be a tight fit it is recommended that when travelling with a child, a Safari 4WD is considered.



Safari 4WD PFMRS

This vehicle has positioning for a total of two child restraints.

Two baby seats (**three years and under**) can be fitted to the rear forward facing seat with a baby bolt.

OR two booster seats (**minimum four years of age**) can be fitted to the rear forward facing seat with a diagonal lap-sash belt.



Challenger 4WD 2B4WDBC

This vehicle has positioning for a total of one child restraint.

Baby seats cannot be fitted in this vehicle. Children **under four years** must not travel in this vehicle.

One booster seat (**minimum four years of age**) needs to be strapped in the front passenger seat with the diagonal lap-sash seatbelt by law. Any other travellers will need to sit in the middle seat. As this may be a tight fit it is recommended that when travelling with a child, a Safari 4WD is considered.



4WD Car PFMR

This vehicle has positioning for a total of two child restraints.

Two baby seats (**three years and under**) can be fitted to the rear forward facing seat with a baby bolt.
OR two booster seats (**minimum four years of age**) can be fitted to the rear forward facing seat with a diagonal lap-sash belt.
